6. Passenger categories eligible to reduced fare

- 6.1. Children who have not started obtaining primary education (hereinafter pre-school children) have the right to travel on the train free of charge, presenting a free ticket (ticket for zero euros) with the year of birth of the child, received at the ticket office or from the conductor controller. Pre-school children may travel on the train only accompanied by an adult.
- 6.2. The following categories of passengers are entitled to a free ticket presenting a corresponding certificate together with a free ticket (ticket for zero euros) received at the ticket office or from the conductor controller with the last four digits of the number of the certificate:
 - 6.2.1. orphans and children left without parental care who are in foster families, guardianship, child care institutions or studying in general or vocational education institutions, as well as in universities and colleges until the age of 24;
 - 6.2.2. persons under the age of 18 with a disability and a person accompanying the person under 18 years of age with a disability;
 - 6.2.3. persons with disabilities of Group I and persons accompanying a person with disability of Group I;
 - 6.2.4. persons with disabilities of Group II;
 - 6.2.5. politically repressed persons;
 - 6.2.6. participants to the National Resistance Movement.
- 6.3. Persons belonging to the "large family" reduced fare category are entitled to the following train fare reductions:
 - 6.3.1. presenting an ID card or passport together with the Latvian Honorary Family Card "3+ Ģimenes karte":
 - 6.3.1.1. **50% discount** on one-way tickets;
 - 6.3.1.2. **40% discount** on day or subscription tickets;
 - 6.3.2. students (up to the age of 24) presenting an ID card, passport, student card together with the Latvian Honorary Family Card "3+ Gimenes karte" 90% discount on one-way tickets;
 - 6.3.3. all members of a large family presenting documents referred to in Clauses 6.3.1 or 6.3.2 on **4 May, 11 and 18 November 100% discount** on one-way tickets;
- 6.4. For members of a large family, the right to travel on the train is confirmed by a ticket purchased at the ticket office or on the train together with the Latvian Honorary Family Card "3+ Gimenes karte" and personal identification document (ID card or passport),

and for students – a ticket together with the Latvian Honorary Family Card "3+ Gimenes karte" and ID card, passport, student card.
