2. Procedures for baggage transport in passenger trains

- 2.1. Passengers may carry their baggage, which is easy to carry and whose type and packaging allows it to be easily placed in the intended place, and whose dimensions (length, width, height) **do not exceed** 60 x 40 x 20 cm, and weight does not exceed 20 kg, for free.
- 2.2. Baggage may not be placed in a place intended for passengers or where it causes inconvenience to other passengers.
- 2.3. Crutches, strollers, wheelchairs for disabled persons and baggage with **one** of its dimensions (length, width, height) exceeding 60 x 40 x 20 cm (such as a collapsible fishing rod, skis, sledges) may be carried free of charge if the technical capabilities of the train allow it.
- 2.4. Passengers have the right to carry baggage with dimensions (length, width, height) **exceeding** 60 x 40 x 20 cm for a charge if the sum of the dimensions (length, width, height) does not exceed 200 cm and if it does not cause inconvenience to other passengers. Transportation of baggage is subject to a baggage ticket.
- 2.5. Passengers who are entitled to a reduced fare in the territory of Latvia, shall pay for baggage exceeding the free baggage allowance in accordance with the tariffs approved by the carrier.
- 2.6. The passenger shall ensure that the baggage is carried in appropriate packaging for transport and storage.
- 2.7. It is prohibited to carry items on the train that may harm other passengers, their baggage or the train. It is prohibited to carry dangerous items (including substances), explosives or highly flammable items (including substances), as well as oxidising, toxic, radioactive or corrosive, unpleasantly smelling substances or items that may cause infections, as well as items (including substances) that may cause inconvenience to other passengers.
- 2.8. Bicycles are carried on a train with special bicycle holders in accordance with the number of bicycle holders for a charge. If a train is not equipped with bicycle holders, the number of bicycles carried in a train wagon shall not exceed 5 (five) bicycles.
